



Export Financing Financing program for companies exporting to the U.S.

With the working capital line for Exports to the U.S., the Mexican exporter converts its **receivables** into cash without risk to the Company.



- "Multi-buyer" lines of credit revolving with terms of up to 120 days for each American buyer.
- There is no limit to the number of American customers.
- Approved in 4 weeks once the credit file is completed.

• All sales to an American customer are payable in USD. The obligation to pay the credit in the same currency is maintained.

• The Mexican exporter receives a cash payment for the 100% invoice value for its exports, against evidence of shipment.

• The American buyer will gain 30 to 120 days of credit for its purchases to the Mexican exporter – no recourse against the Mexican exporter in case the American buyer does not pay this credit.

• The Mexican exporter eliminates the receivables and the risk of collection on its books.

• The Mexican exporter eliminates the insurance on its receivables and the paperwork and controls required by the insurer.

- It recovers its working capital immediately at the time of the sale.
- Loans from US\$200,000 to US\$5,000,000 for each American buyer.
- Each disbursement may be made for a minimum of US\$20,000.
- It is handled as an "off-balance sheet" credit.
- There is no VAT in the transaction.
- The exporter does not have to rely on Bancomext for this credit for working capital.
- No guarantees, no deposits, no reciprocity, or collateral.

• The exporter can increase its sales to the U.S. by providing credit to its American customers with this loan facility and without risk to the exporter.

• The exporter's position is strengthened in its negotiations with American customers.

• We do not require a checking account, payroll administration, or any other reciprocity in exchange for the credit.

• The exporter obtains the working capital on the same day of the invoice to close its cycle of "inventory-manufacturing-sale-collection" ... **and grows its exports**.
